



Over-the-Counter Drugs are now considered qualified **HSA, FSA, and HRA** expenses!

Effective March 27, 2020, as part of the Omnibus CARES Act, individuals with pre-tax savings accounts (Health Savings Accounts, Flexible Spending Accounts, or Health Reimbursement Accounts) can now pay for over-the-counter drugs and menstrual products with pre-tax dollars, or file for reimbursement.

Individuals can purchase over-the-counter medicines related to COVID-19 treatment, or related to the treatment and management of any health care condition and receive pre-tax benefits when spending.



The Act states that these products are reimbursable going back to **JANUARY 1, 2020.**

Individuals who have receipts for these purchases dating back to January 1, 2020 can file for reimbursement for their expenses.
